

## shut down & cleaning

Refer to the BioLite CampStove Instruction Manual for the shutdown procedure for the CampStove.
 Wait at least 10 minutes after fire has completely burned out before handling Grill attachment. Do NOT remove while fire or embers are still active in CampStove.
 Remove Grill from CampStove and fold legs inward as pictured.
 Place Travel Cover over too and bottom opening of Grill for easy partability without mess. Grill must be completely cooled before applying Travel Cover.

To clean on-site, wipe down cooled grill with a damp rag. Clean thoroughly with wire brush when available. Dry thoroughly after cleaning.

DO NOT remove Grill while fire or embers are still active in CampStove as this can create a burn hazard. When dumping embers, remember to extinguish them because live embers can start fires.

### NOTICE

To protect stove and Grill's components, never pour water into Grill - **NEVER**. Exposure to extreme temperature changes via water can damage Grill.
